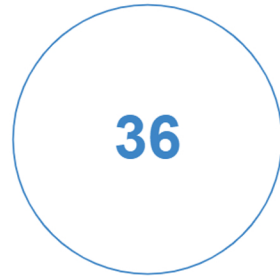

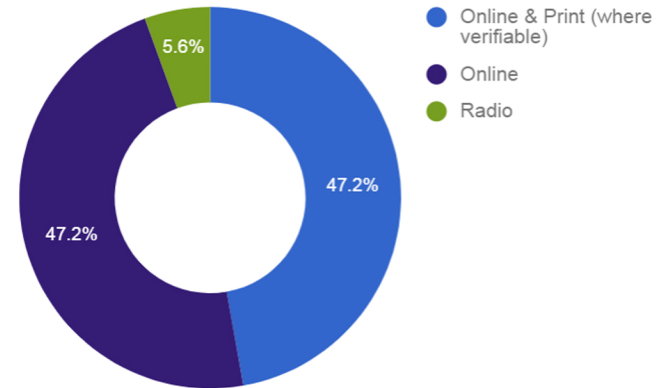

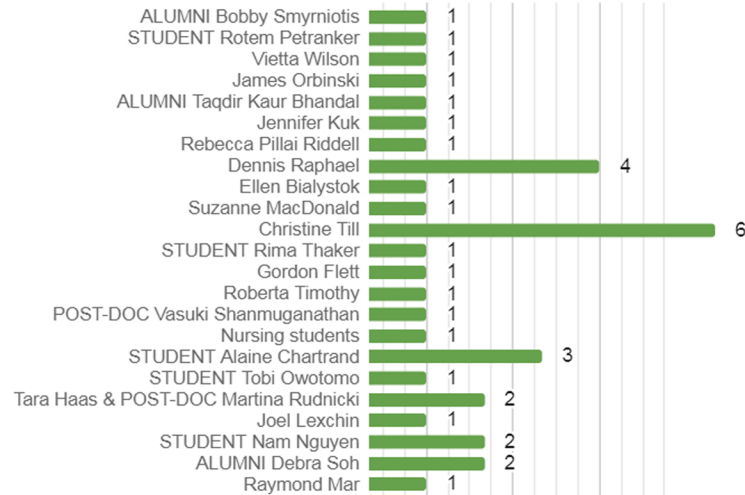
## Total # of stories
